## 2014 TIES Program Committee Regional Report

### **Activity and Focus Since Last Meeting**

Beginning July 1, 2014, Krishna Jandhyala, Chair of the TIES Program Committee, Quanxi Shao, Conference Chair; and Bronwyn Harch, TIES President and have been meeting via Skype on a regular. These meetings enabled them to ensure that preparations for TIES 2014 progressed at a steady pace and in an effective manner. For example, the conference registration procedures were streamlined so that registration was easily accessible to all potential participants. Ideas were generated in order to increase Invited Sessions. Many other finer details of the conference preparations were also discussed as the conference date neared. By now, there is confidence that preparations for TIES 2014 are all well in place and hopefully all participants will find the conference to be productive and enjoyable.

What follows below is a brief summary of preparations in place for the conference.

1. Website: The Conference Website Home Page can be accessed at

2. **Registration:** Easily accessible Conference Registration Form is available online (visit via Home Page), which contains all information about Registration. Registration amount can be paid online.

3. **Abstracts:** Deadline for abstract submission has been extended to October 31, 2014. The conference organizers will continue to accept abstracts for some more time. All potential speakers have been requested to submit the titles and abstracts of their talks ASAP.

4. **VISA to China:** VISA is necessary for all internationals. Information about how to get VISA is available online. Reminders are being sent via E-mail to all conference Registrants and to all session organizers.

#### 5. Keynote Speakers:

The Stuart Hunter Lecturer - Prof Tata Subba Rao, University of Manchester The President's Invited Lecturer - Prof Jixian Zhang, President, Chinese Academy of Surveying & Mapping

6. **Invited Sessions:** Currently, there are 19 Invited TIES Sessions and 12 are expected to be organized by Division of Resource and Environment Statistics, Chinese Association for Applied Statistics.

7. **Contributed Sessions:** The final number is not yet known because the local organizing committee is communicating with all the registrants to ensure that there are no talks missing. Currently there are 15 contributed abstracts from TIES members.

8. **Poster Presentations:** The final number is yet unknown. Currently 6 are confirmed from TIES members.

9. **Financial Status and Outlook:** So far 43 registrations from TIES members. The final numbers from TIES side may be slightly less than planned. If it is the case, we will reduce the number of parallel sessions to reduce the cost. The financial outlook is healthy.

10. **Organizational Logistics:** The local organizing committee will start the logistics implementation and communication from mid-November, covering registration, bus transfers on Days 1 and 2 and the Conference Tour.

11. AGM and Board Meeting Logistics: The WIFI signal was tested and it works fine.

12. **Overall Outlook:** Although there were some problems with the online registration, we have worked hard to ensure registration is now working smoothly. The number of participants may be smaller than the planned 220. The financial status is healthy because the majority of registrants are from developed countries.

## Activity and Focus Since Last Meeting

- TIES Partnerships with Journals
  - TIES conference proceedings in *Journal of Environmental Statistics* 
    - Committee reconfirmed this as an option for conference organisers to avail themselves of this for their meetings. Was first used for TIES2012 in India. TIES2013 and TIES2014 did not avail themselves of this opportunity
  - o TIES conference proceedings in *Environmetrics* 
    - Support TIES Award winners to publish papers in Environmetrics Journal
    - Agreement with Editor to identify high calibre papers through conferences and work to fast track them for submission to the *Environmetrics Journal*
    - Agreement in principle received from Editor to consider a Special Issue of journal for TIES 25th conference anniversary (Need to work out implementation details)
  - Progressing a potential new award that showcases the best Environmetrics Journal paper and that author(s) is(are) invited to the following TIES meeting to present the paper. The idea is that we approach Wiley about funding this award.
- TIES Newsletter
  - Editor of *Environmetrics Journal*, now allotted space for brief article to update TIES members on journal activities
  - Identified that book reviews are now longer include din *Environmetrics Journal* – an opportunity to handle these through the TIES newsletter
- Website
  - Regular updates have been made to website, as needed.
  - Established "strengthening-TIES" email list. Anyone can self subscribe and post to this list. TIES Secretary is vetting it for content prior to postings being sent.
    - "strengthening\_TIES" is a mailing list which reaches people globally, who have an interest in statistical and other quantitative methods in the environmental sciences, environmental engineering and environmental monitoring and protection. Membership of the list is open to any interested person who chooses to subscribe. List members include stakeholders from universities, government and private enterprise. The list has been in operation since October 2014.
