Purpose:

 To present the financial statements and report of the Auditor for the Society

Background:

 As outlined in the By-Laws, the financial situation of the Society is to be presented at each annual general meeting, along with the appointment of the Auditor for the next year



 The current positive balance for TIES is around USD \$52,948 (without accounting for ISI liabilities)

 The crude estimate of the TIES Budget today if TIES pays all ISI liabilities for all previous years
 2010-2013 is around USD\$23,000

So, TIES is financially viable

- TIES main annual sources of income:
 - membership revenue (USD\$5,000)
 - occasionally conferences (USD\$5,000)

- TIES main annual expenses:
 - ISI liabilities (USD\$6,600)
 - accountant in Canada (USD\$3,500)*
 - guest speakers/awards (USD\$3,000-\$7,000)



- ISI charges TIES around USD\$4,600 as **overhead** and at least USD\$2,000 for **membership administration**. In total, TIES is supposed to pay ISI at least USD\$6,600 each year under current membership numbers
- TIES pays public accountant in Canada around USD \$3,500 for **annual review engagement**. However, under the new Canadian Non-for-Profit Act, TIES does not need a public accountant anymore (for details see the Treasurer Report)*. Cost of TIES in Canada will be USD\$0
